Dear Mr. Nestle:

The Board for Geologists and Geophysicists (BGG) received your letter (attached) requesting re-opening of the complaint against Mr. [REDACTED]. This letter confirms our discussion during the teleconference with you, Mr. Mike Luksic, Mr. Paul Sweeney and me this morning. The complaint against Mr. [REDACTED] (Registered Civil Engineer No. [REDACTED]) was referred to the Board for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (BPELS) for review and possible enforcement action. This decision was made in accordance with the BGG and BPELS policy to refer complaints against a licensed professional to that professional's respective licensing Board or Bureau to determine if there is a potential violation of that professional's licensing act, rules or regulations.

Since Mr. [REDACTED] is a licensed Civil Engineer, the case was forwarded to BPELS for review. Depending on the outcome of the BPELS evaluation of Mr. [REDACTED]'s case, the case may be referred back to the BGG for review and possible action. This case has also been reviewed by both members of the Board's Enforcement Oversight Committee (EOC) and they concur with this approach.
