FROM HUGH ROBERTSON, LEGISLATION COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN

The following bills which may have some impact on our profession are making their way through the legilature.

Certificate of Merit Law: This existing law, which is designed to provide design professionals with some measure of protection from frivolous or unfounded malpractice actions, is due to "sunset" on 1/1/89. Various professional engineering and geotechnical groups are working to extend the statute. The law requires that before filing a complaint, the Attorney representing the plaintiff must certify that a qualified design professional of the same discipline has been consulted as to the merits of the complaint. Please provide comments as to whether you support extending the Certificate of Merit statute beyond its sunset date.

SB 617-Green would give private engineers hired as plan checkers by public agencies and building departments the same immunity as the agency plan checkers. It has been suggested that AEG support amending this bill to add geologists. any comments?
